Quay Wall Inspections – Town Quay Amended

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that quay wall inspections will be continuing to take place across the Port of Southampton and will complete approximately at the end of December 2025. On 14th November 2025

A specialized contractor Constructex will be conducting the inspections during daylight hours only with the support of a small Orkney 20 Pilot House. The callsign for the support vessel 'SV1' will be used to support the engineers when any waterside inspections or diving inspections are being conducted.



From Monday 10th November to Friday 14th November waterline inspections, including diving operations, will be carried out along Town Quay (in the below marked area)

Upon completion of these works, all quay wall inspections across the port will have been concluded.



Work boat **SV1** will display the lights, shapes and flags as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are requested to reduce speed and give a wide berth with minimum wash as safe navigation permits when passing. **SV1** will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 12.
